### Terms and Conditions:-

- 1. The Agency must be registered with the Tax Department and a copy of registration certificate to this effect, duly signed and stamped by the authorized person of the Company must be enclosed with the quotation(s)/bids.
- 2. Successful bidders may note that there shall not be phased/part payment in this work during its execution. The payment shall made on the basis of 1st and Final bill within reasonable period through crossed Cheque after successful completion of work.
- 3. The rate agreed upon in the agreement should remain valid for the entire period of agreement with no escalation allowed what so ever.
- 4. The modification of window counter shall be **as per given specification** elsewhere in the tender document. The bidders are advised to visit the existing window counters before the submission of bids for better understanding of work to be executed.
- 5. Defect liability period of the work is one year from the date of completion of work. Within Defect liability period any defects arises should be rectified free of cost.
- 6. Embassy reserves the right to terminate the contract in case the Agency/contractor's services/works are of substandard quality or violates any of the conditions given in the agreement.
- 7. Embassy of India, Kathmandu reserves the right to reject/accept any sealed quotation/s without assigning any reason thereto.
- 8. The Bank guarantee/DD/FDR submitted as EMD shall remain valid for a period of 180 days from the date of opening of bids and shall be payable at Kathmandu only.
- 9. Earnest Money will be forfeited for following reasons:
  - i) If the bidder withdraws his bid during the period of bid validity.
  - ii) In case of the successful bidder, if the bidder fails to sign the contract.

### 10. Refund of EMD :-

- i) Refund of EMD to the unsuccessful bidders (Without interest) shall be made after expiry of the bid validity period and latest on or before 30th day from the date of award of contract.
- ii) EMD of successful bidder shall be refunded after award of the contract and deposit of Performance Security.
- 11. Performance Security: The successful bidder shall deposit Performance Security @ 8% of the total value in the form of Bank Guarantee/Demand Draft in the name of "Embassy of India, Kathmandu" at the time of signing of contract. The Performance Security should be valid till 60 days beyond the completion of Defect Liability Period. After successful

completion of all contractual obligations and Defect liability period, the Performance Security should (Without Interest) shall be refunded.

- 12. The workers engaged by the Contractor will be the employees of the Contractor and the Employer will not, in any way, be responsible for any liability/compensation on account of accident, injury or death of workers while performing their work inside the Embassy premises. The contractor shall indemnify the Employer against any claim with regard violation of any labour laws and claims thereof.
- 13. The time period for execution of work shall be 60 days. The time will remain the essence of this contract and under no condition except for justified delays approved by the approving authority no extension of time will be provided.
- 14. In case of delay of work beyond the justified period of work penalty @0.2% of the tendered cost for each day of delay shall be levied on the contractor. The maximum penalty levied shall not be more than 10% of the tendered cost.
- 15. The decision of the approving authority with regard to penalty clause shall be final and binding on the contractor.





# Specification of proposed window counters


- 1. Glass to be used for Window should be 10mm thick toughened Glass of required shape and size after removing the existing glass panes. (Brand-Saint-Gobian or Shyam or Brij Glass or equivalent as decided by approving authority)
- 2. Stainless steel to be used for Tray should be of grade 304 and thickness 1.0 mm. (Brand- Jindal or equivalent as decided by approving authority).
- 3. Tray base should be curved in such a way that end depth of tray should be 50mm and in middle 75 mm. and sliding plate on top should slide on S.S. channels. (Brand- Hettich or equivalent as decided by approving authority).
- **4.** After cutting the rectangular notch/opening of required size of the counter for fixing of tray, 18 mm thick pre finished granite should be fixed at both the vertical faces at the Notch.
- 5. The necessary support for Stainless steel tray should be provided with wood/ply at least 18 mm thickness. (PLY Brand- Greenply or Century or Surya or equivalent as decided by approving authority.)
- **6.** Counter should be cut by mechanical/electrical equipments without making damage to the remaining structure at the counter. Any damage made to the remaining structure of the counter shall be rectified by the contractor without any additional payment.
- 7. 2 way counter communication system having similar specification to MEGA (CCS-2020), AHUJA (CCS-2200) or equivalent as decided by the approving authority.
- **8.** Making necessary connections i/c wiring, PVC wiring channel etc for proper working of 2 way counter communication system or equivalent.
