ADMISSION IN THREE ARMY PUBLIC SCHOOLS (APS) IN INDIA UNDER APS SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME 2022-23

Embassy of India, Kathmandu invites applications from Nepalese nationals (boys and girls) desirous of seeking admission in Class VI to IX and XI in following Army Public Schools.

(i)	APS Pithoragarh (Uttarakhand)	- Class VI & XI (boys & girls)
(ii)	APS Dhaula Kuan (Delhi)	- Class VI to IX (boys only)
(iii)	APS Noida (UP)	- Class VI to IX (girls only)

2. Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates desirous to apply should fulfill the following criteria:-

- (i) The candidate applying for admission in class VI and onwards must have passed previous class before applying for next class. ***Appearing students will not be considered for the next higher class. It is mandatory to submit copy of final mark sheet of class V & onwards, as the case may be, for seeking admission in next higher class and original certificate from the school principal where the candidate is studying regarding current status of the student in the school.***
- (ii) Candidates must have good proficiency in English.
- (iii) Candidates should be medically fit.

3. Age Criteria :

Candidates should fulfill the following age criteria :-

Class	Minimum Age (as on 31.03.2022)	Maximum Age (as on 31.03.2022)
VI	10 Years	12 Years
VII	11 Years	13 Years
VIII	12 Years	14 Years
IX	13 Years	15 Years
XI	15 Years	17 Years

4. Instructions for filling up application:

Application forms, in bio-data format, may be submitted by post/courier or personally at the Education Wing of Embassy of India, Kathmandu not before February 10, 2022 and not later than February 28, 2022 between 10:00 hrs to 17:00 hrs. The applicant must deposit application fee of **NRs. 400/- (Four Hundred only)** in favour of Embassy of India, Kathmandu **Account Number 17725240200331 in Nepal SBI Bank only, anywhere in Nepal.** Desirous applicants should submit the following documents along with the original counterfoil of Bank Voucher:

- (a) Complete bio-data of student in English language with one attached photo.
- (b) Notary Public attested photocopy of date of birth certificate issued by Municipality.
- (c) Notary Public attested photocopy mark sheet of last exam passed.
- (d) Notary Public attested photocopy of father/mother Citizenship in English Transcript.
- (e) A certificate from Headmaster/Principal of the school last attended stating that the student has passed last class from Govt. or Private school as the case may be and that he/she is proficient in English
- (f) Medical fitness certificate

5. Selection Process:

An English test / interview would be held in Embassy of India, Kathmandu to select meritorious and deserving students on the basis of screening/marks. **Selection of candidates in the interview does not guarantee admission in APS unless their placement is confirmed by respective APS in India.**
