G-20 Summit, New Delhi held on 09-10 September 2023



The 18th G20 Summit in New Delhi was a culmination of all the G20 processes and meetings held throughout the year among ministers, senior officials and civil societies. A G20 Leaders' Declaration was adopted at the conclusion of the G20 Summit, stating Leaders' commitment towards the priorities discussed and agreed upon during the respective ministerial and working group meetings.









India in Nepal Highlights



Inauguration and Handing over of Community Development Projects



Ambassador of India to Nepal, H.E. Mr. Naveen Srivastava visited Kanchanpur and Kailali districts of Sudurpashchim province from 17-18 September 2023. During his visit, Ambassador Srivastava inaugurated and handed over three Community Development Projects to local District authorities: (i) Campus Building of Tikapur Multiple Campus, Kailali; (ii) School Buildings in Shree Pashupati Shiksha Mandir; and (iii) Shree Siddhanath Secondary School in Kanchanpur. These projects completed through Government of India's financial assistance of NRs. 90.80 million will augment the educational infrastructure of the area for the benefit of youth.







Inauguration of School Campus in Sankhuwasabha



Hon'ble Foreign Minister of Nepal, H.E. Mr. N.P. Saud and Ambassador of India to Nepal, H.E. Mr. Naveen Srivastava jointly inaugurated the campus building of Himalaya Kiran Public Campus, Sankhuwasabha on 06 September 2023. The project was undertaken with Government of India's grant of NRs.37.40 million. Foreign Minister Saud mentioned that it was a matter of pride and Nepal was fortunate to have neighbour like India who has contributed to development of Nepal and its people. He further said that he looked forward to continued support from India in Nepal's development. Ambassador Srivastava highlighted that this project is an important facet of the very robust development partnership between India and Nepal, which has made significant strides in the recent years.
