Second Edition of Bihar Museum Biennale 2023



Hon'ble Chief Minister of Bihar, Mr Nitish Kumar inaugurated the second edition of the Bihar Museum Biennale 2023 at Patna on 07 August 2023. The Biennale is part of the G20 initiative during India's Presidency for the year 2023. The biennnale showcased a unique initiative to provide a platform to musuems, musuem professionals and artists. Nepal Art Council, led by president, Mr. Sagar SJB Rana, also participated in the prestigious Bihar Museum Biennale 2023.

As part of the inauguration, an exhibition of G20 member and guest countries, "Together We Art" was launched. Nepal Art Council showcased 'Nepal -Where the Gods Reside', an exhibition of 205 artworks by 68 artists, in approximately, 4,000 sq. ft., making it the largest representation of Nepali artists outside the country. The Nepal gallery attracted special attention and it's centrally placed colourful Pancha Buddha and Ashta Mangala Mandala was the highlight of the show. The exhibition will be on for two months till October 2023.



Chandrayan-3: India reaches the Moon





India created history when India's Chandrayaan-3 Moon mission successfully accomplished landing on Moon's South Pole on 23 August 2023. India thus became the fourth country in the history to have softlanded a spacecraft on the Moon, and the first to have done so in the Moon's south polar region. Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) launched the Chandrayaan-3 lunar lander aboard an LVM3 M4 launch vehicle on 14 July 2023.

Prime Minister's visit to South Africa and Greece













Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi visited Johannesburg, South Africa from 22-24 August 2023 to attend the 15th BRICS Summit, at the invitation of H.E. Mr. Matamela Cyril Ramaphosa, President of the Republic of South Africa. This was the first in-person BRICS Summit since 2019. Prime Minister also participated in a special event "BRICS – Africa Outreach and BRICS Plus Dialogue" organized after the BRICS Summit, which also included other countries invited by South Africa. Prime Minister was also on official visit to Greece on 25 August 2023 at the invitation of H.E. Mr. Kyriakos Mitsotakis, Prime Minister of Greece.



Kumbhalgarh Fort, Rajasthan



Located about 84 km from Udaipur, Kumbhalgarh Fort, also known as the Great Wall of India, is a Mewar fortress on the westerly range of Aravalli Hills, just about 48 km from Rajsamand city in the Rajsamand district of the Rajasthan state in western India. It is a World Heritage Site included in Hill Forts of Rajasthan. Built on a hilltop 1,100 m above sea level on the Aravalli range, the perimeter of Kumbhalgarh fort is among the longest walls in the world.
