India in Nepal Highlights

Projects Portfolio Performance Review Meeting



Embassy of India, Kathmandu and Ministry of Finance, Government of Nepal (GoN) held Projects Portfolio Performance Review Meeting on 01 December 2023. The Indian side was led by Ambassador of India to Nepal, H.E. Shri Naveen Srivastava and Nepali side was led by Finance Minister of Nepal, H.E. Dr. Prakash Sharan Mahat. During the meeting, Ambassador Srivastava highlighted India's robust development cooperation with Nepal and reiterated Government of India's (GoI) commitment and support towards working with GoN in the future towards development cooperation. Finance Minister Dr. Mahat appreciated the GoI's development support and expressed GoN's commitment to further enhance this cooperation in other potential sectors as well.








Did you miss out!

Largest tabla ensemble Guinness record set at Gwalior Tansen festival



Around 1,300 musicians performed on tabla in tandem to enter the Guinness World Record for the "largest Tabla ensemble" during the International Tansen Mahotsav in Gwalior on an eventful day on 25 December 2023. The feat comes just a month after Gwalior was designated as the Creative City of Music in the UNESCO Creative Cities Network (UCCN) in November. On the historic occasion, Chief Minister Dr Mohan Yadav received the certificate from the Guinness World Records organization.








Did you visit?

Rani Ki Vav in Gujarat, India



Rani Ki Vav is an intricately constructed stepwell situated in the town of Patan in Gujarat, India. It is located on the banks of Saraswati River. Rani ki Vav was built as a memorial to an 11th-century AD King Bhimdev - I. It was added to the list of UNESCO's World Heritage Sites in June 2014. Rani ki Vav is a single-component, water management system divided into seven levels of stairs and sculptural panels of high artistic and aesthetic quality.
