- (a) One combustion chamber
- (b) Free burning, requiring no fuel or electricity
- (c) Atleast 1.25 meter refractory lined chimney
- (d) Smut arrester
- (e) Ash rake
- (f) Burn rate of 15 Kg/h
- (g) Made in India product shall be preferred

INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERER

- 3. The agency shall attach detailed specifications, model No and one photograph of the proposed incinerator.

4. Eligibility criteria:

5. Local Conditions:

It shall be the responsibility on part of each tenderer to fully informed/acquainted/familiarized itself with local conditions and factors, which may

have any effect on the execution of services to be rendered under the contract.

The Embassy shall presume that the tenderer has understood and agreed that all the relevant factors have been kept in view while submitting the bid. No financial adjustment arising thereof shall be permitted by Embassy, on the basis of any non-clarity of information about local conditions being pleaded by the tenderer. Further, no claim for financial adjustment being made by the contract awarded on these tender document will be entertained by the Embassy.

6. Validity:

- 6.1 Quoted rates must be valid for a period of 180 days from the last date of submission of bids. However, the tenderer should have no objection to extend it, if required by the Embassy.
- 6.2 The overall offer for the assignment and tenderer(s) quoted price shall remain unchanged during the period of validity. There should be no alteration later after submission of bids.

7. Installation & Commissioning:

After finalization of the tender, purchase order shall be issued by the Embassy. The product shall be supplied, installed and commissioned within four weeks from the date of issue of this letter.

8. Payment Terms & Conditions:

The payment shall be released to the contractor after successful supply, installation, commissioning and testing of the equipment at the site after ensuring desired quality and specifications of the articles. No advance payment shall be made to the agency.

9. Guarantee period: The following warranty will form part of the contract placed on successful Bidder-

Except as otherwise provided in the invitation tender, the Supplier hereby declares that the goods, stores articles sold / supplied to the Embassy under this contract shall be of the best quality and workmanship and new in all respects and shall be strictly in accordance with the specification contained in the contract. Any breakdown during a period of first 12 months shall be rectified without any charge. To obviate any breakdown, the supplier shall ensure preventive maintenance from time to time during first year of operation.

10. Financial Bid:

10.1 The rates should be quoted in Nepalese Rupees (NPR) inclusive of all taxes/duties, transportation, installation and other charges, if any.

11. Force Majeure:

Any delay due to Force Majeure will not be attributable to the bidder. Force Majeure events shall mean one or more of the following acts or events: Acts of God or

events beyond the reasonable control of the Affected Party which could not reasonably have been expected to occur, exceptionally adverse weather conditions, lightning, earthquake, cyclone, flood, volcanic eruption or fire or landslide; Radioactive contamination or ionizing radiation; Strikes or boycotts (other than those involving the Supplier or its employees / representatives or attributable to any act or omission of any of them) interrupting supplies and services of the Project for a period exceeding a continuous period of 7 (seven) days; An act of war (whether declared or undeclared), invasion, armed conflict or act of foreign enemy, blockade, embargo, riot, insurrection, terrorist or military action, civil commotion or politically motivated sabotage which prevents rendering of supplies or specified services by the Supplier for a period exceeding a continuous period of 7 (seven) days.

12. Arbitration:

In case of any dispute or difference arising out of or in connection with the tender conditions / order and Contract, the Embassy and the Supplier will address the dispute / difference on a mutual resolution and failing which, the matter shall be referred for arbitration to a sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Embassy. The Arbitration shall be held in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the venue of arbitration shall be at New Delhi only. The resolution of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.

13. Jurisdiction:

The courts at New Delhi alone will have the jurisdiction to try any matter, dispute or reference between parties arising out of this tender / contract.

14. Clarification:
