Terms and conditions for the sale of Vehicle

1. The Tender document can be downloaded from Embassy's website <https://www.indembkathmandu.gov.in> and www.eprocure.gov.in.
2. No bid shall be accepted after the scheduled date and time. The sealed cover should be super scribed "Bid for Nissan X-Trail" with full name, contact number and postal address of the Bidder.
3. The last date of submission of the bids in a sealed envelope is 20-08-2026 up to 03:00 pm. The bids must be dropped in the tender box kept at the main gate of Embassy of India, Kathmandu, 336 Kapurdhara Marg, Kathmandu Nepal-44600.
4. A bidder must be/have a person/registered firm.
5. The conditional bid shall not be accepted.
6. The vehicle will be sold on "As is where is & whatever there is basis" and no guarantee or certificate of its worthiness or quality will be given by our department. No requests for inspection of vehicle other than as mention above (specified day & time) will be entertained.
7. The bidder shall furnish Earnest Money Deposit mentioned above by way of Demand Draft/ Pay Order/Cheque issued by a scheduled commercial bank in favor

of 'Embassy of India, Kathmandu' payable at Nepal SBI Ltd., Extension Counter, Embassy of India, Kathmandu. The Earnest Money Deposit of the unsuccessful bidder shall be returned subsequent to the award of contract to the successful bidder. No claim lies against Embassy of India in respect of erosion in the value or interest on the amount of Earnest Money Deposit (i.e. Earnest Money Deposit will be interest free). The bid without Earnest Money Deposit will be summarily rejected.

8. The successful bidder after acceptance of his/her bid will be required to deposit the accepted bid amount within **7 (Seven)** working days from the date of issue of work order/ Intent letter from Embassy of India. The final sale amount (after adjusting of Earnest Money Deposit amount) is to be deposited in the form of DD/PO/RTGS/NEFT/Cheque, failing which the earnest money will be forfeited.

9. The sold items is to be lifted from the site within a specified date from the issue of release order or such period as may be decided by the authority on an "as is where is and whatever there is basis".

10. Postal delays will not accepted as an excuse for late submission of tender.

11. The scheduled day for opening of the sealed tenders, if declared to be holiday due to any unforeseen reason, the same will be opened on the next immediate working day at 03:30 P.M.

12. The successful bidder will also be responsible for getting the Registration Certificate of the vehicle transferred in his name at his own cost expeditiously. The Embassy will not be responsible for any lapse on his part in this regard.

13. The buyer will be responsible for safety and security of the sold items after delivery of items to the successful bidder. Embassy of India will not be responsible for any damage/pilferage of the auctioned items.

14. The delivery of the sold vehicle will be given only to the successful/ H-1 Highest bidder.

15. Taxes and duties that may be levied by the Government of Nepal will be borne by the bidder.

16. The sold vehicle shall have to be removed by successful bidder at his own expenses from Embassy's premises.

17. If, the Buyer fails to make the requisite payment within the time/extended time stipulated, the sale relating to old car can be cancelled at the discretion of the Embassy/Seller/Auctioneer and the Earnest Money deposited by the Bidder shall be forfeited in full and the Seller/Auctioneer shall be entitled to recover any incidental/consequential loss suffered by it as a result of such failure. The Seller/Auctioneer shall not be bound to give any notice to the buyer for the said forfeiture.

18. Embassy of India reserves the right to accept/reject the offers or cancel the whole auction proceeding without assigning any reason whatsoever.
