The work is estimated to cost about INR 38.43 crores (including VAT), which however, is to be taken merely as a guide. 2. The **objective** of this Notice Inviting Tender is to select an appropriately qualified and adequately experienced Contractor by the Embassy of India Kathmandu, Nepal for Interiors & AV equipment alongwith balance civil, electrical & plumbing works for existing auditorium and other buildings in the Embassy of India complex at Kathmandu, Nepal.

## 3. Location and description of Property:

The site of work is situated within the Embassy of India complex at 336, Kapurdhara Marg, Kathmandu, Nepal, which is a prime location in the heart of Kathmandu. The new buildings have already been constructed at site from where the Embassy is functioning. However, interiors & allied works alongwith certain balance works in the Auditorium, Multi-Purpose Hall, Ancillary building, Library, Indoor games hall of the sports building, etc. as well as some external site development works are to be carried out and made operational. Structures of these buildings have already been constructed.

## 4. Scope of Work:

The scope of work will include the execution of all the interiors, providing and installation of furnishings, acoustic treatments, Audio-Video equipments, floorings, CCTV camera & access control systems, stage lighting & curtains, auditorium chairs, bullet resistant glass windows, stone/ wooden carving works, granite flooring including patterned design, demolishing/ dismantling, rectification of defective works, LED lights, alongwith all balance civil, electrical, fire alarm & fire-fighting works, internal painting works, etc, execution of finishes and related civil, plumbing & electrical works which would include floorings in balance areas etc., preparation of shop drawings, samples & mock-ups and obtaining approval from the Employer/ Architect before undertaking fabrication and/ execution of defective works in the newly constructed auditorium & other buildings of the complex and all other incidental works etc. as per BOQ.

# 5. Period of Completion:

The entire work is to be completed and commissioned in 12 (Twelve) months from the date of commencement.

- 6. Tender: The bidding will take place in two stages:

  - (ii) **Stage-II**: Eligible firms would be issued with tender documents for submission of Item rate financial bid.

- 3. Technical bids will be opened at 16:00 hrs on 21 March 2022 at the Embassy of India, Kathmandu, Nepal. Applicants may send their representative to be present during opening of bids after obtaining prior permission from the Embassy of India, Kathmandu, Nepal.
- 4. The Tender shall remain valid for a period of One Hundred Eighty (180) days from the date of opening or till any extended period.

#### 5. Eligibility Criteria:

**5.1 Permit**: The Tenderer should have valid permit/ registration from a competent local authority for carrying out the work in Kathmandu, Nepal.

#### 5.2 Similar work:

The Tenderer must have satisfactorily completed in the last seven years (i) one similar work of value not less than INR 30.75 Crore or (ii) two similar works of value not less than INR 19.21 Crore or (iii) three similar works of value not less than INR 15.38 Crore. Similar work means carrying out the work of interior, acoustic, audio-video works, stage lighting & stage furnishing in an auditorium with minimum seating capacity of not less than 400 persons including carrying out all civil, utility services and allied works (executed under single contract) for buildings such as Modern office buildings, Hotels, shopping malls, Embassies, Universities, etc. The work in which compensation has been levied for delayed completion shall not be considered for eligibility. Commencement Certificate and Completion Certificate from the Employer will be required to be submitted for similar works.

- **5.3 Bank Solvency**: The tenderer should submit Certificate of Solvency for INR 15.38 Crores or more, certified by bank. The certificate should not be older than a month and it is required to be renewed periodically every six months.
- **5.4 Annual Turnover**: The bidder should have had average annual financial turn-over of INR 11.53 Crores (excluding VAT) or more on Construction works during the immediate last three consecutive financial years. This should be duly audited/certified by a Chartered Accountant. Year in which no turnover is shown would also be considered for working out the average.
- **5.5 Profit-Loss**: The applicant should be a profit making company/firm and should not have suffered any financial loss in more than two years in the previous five financial years and must not have suffered loss in the immediate preceding financial year. This fact shall be duly certified by the Chartered Accountant and audited financial statements for these five years will be submitted by the bidder.
- **5.6 Joint venture**: Joint Venture (JV) firms formed specifically for this tender shall not be permitted. JV, like a single entity, meeting all eligibility criteria shall be permitted. JV partners meeting eligibility criteria on individual basis separately shall not be permitted.
- 6. Conditions of Contract: Work shall be executed according to the CPWD general conditions of contract, specifications and items of works as well as the special conditions and particular specifications for non-schedule items.
- 6.1 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): The applicant needs to submit Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) INR 48,43,000/- (Indian Rupees Forty eight lakhs, forty three thousand only). This should be in the form of Bank draft or Banker's cheque in favor of Embassy of India in Kathmandu, Nepal or an unconditional and irrevocable Bank Guarantee (as per template given in Section-IV). EMD shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope. EMD shall have to remain valid for a period of ninety days beyond the final bid validity period. EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned at the earliest but not later than the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the L-1 bidder is identified. EMD of successful bidder will be returned after submission of Performance Bank Guarantee. If the successful bidder withdraws or modifies the Bid during the period of validity or after award of the contract fails to sign the contract, or to submit a performance security before the deadline defined in the request for bids document, the EMD will be forfeited.
- **6.2 Retention Money:** Retention Money will be limited to 5% of the accepted tender amount and 5% of each Running bill will be deducted towards retention money. Retention money shall be released against equivalent amount of Bank Guarantee (BG) to be submitted by Contractor. BG should be valid for completion period plus defects liability period. In case of time extension of project, the BG should be revalidated up to extended time plus Defects Liability period.
- **6.3 Performance Security**: This will be equal to 3% of Accepted tender amount. This should be in the form of an unconditional and irrevocable Bank Guarantee (as per template given in Section-V) and should be valid up 60 days beyond the stipulated date of completion. In case of time extension, the validity of Performance security BG should be extended up to 60 days beyond the extended date of completion. Performance Security shall be submitted by the successful bidder within 21 days after notification of award.
- 6.4 VAT clause: The Items rate quote from bidder shall be inclusive of VAT.

6.5 Tender price – This is an item rate tender. The rates quoted shall be composed of all taxes, levies, duties, etc. and taken as firm throughout the tenure of the contract including extension of time, if any granted, upto completion of the Defects Liability Period, and will not be subject to any fluctuation due to the increase in the cost of labour, materials, p.o.l., GST, octroi, VAT/ WCT, labour laws, import/ export duties and/ or any other taxes, transportation costs, etc. All entries should be filled up in English. Bidders should quote their rates both in figures and in words.

The Bidder should note that no unauthorized alterations shall be made in the Tender documents and, if any such alterations are made or if an incomplete Tender is submitted, such Tender shall be liable to rejection.

- **6.6 Liquidated Damage** : It shall be 0.5% per week of delay limited to 10% of accepted tender cost. This shall be calculated on per day basis for each day of delay.
- **6.7** Payment against material (Secured Advance): Payment against 80% of the landed price or 60% of the quoted item price whichever is less rate of non-perishable material brought at site but yet to be used in works shall be allowed as secured advance and this shall be adjusted in Running Account Bill of work done involving material (full or part) as consumed in works.

#### 6.8 Mobilization advance:

- 6.8.1 Mobilization advance (simple interest bearing @ 10% p.a.) will be limited to 10% of tendered amount on submission of non-revocable Bank Guarantee of an amount equal to 110% of the amount of advance
- 6.8.2 The mobilization advance shall be released only on submission of a Bank Guarantee from a schedule bank for the 110% of amount of advance to be released and valid for the contract period. This shall be kept renewed time to time to cover the balance amount and likely period to complete recovery.
- 6.8.3 The advance shall be released in two or more installments.
- 6.8.4 A valid Bank Guarantee should be available for the 110% of amount of outstanding advance at all times.
- 6.8.5 The recovery of mobilization advance shall commence after 10% of work is completed and the entire amount shall be recovered by the time 80% of the work is completed. In case the balance mobilization advance still remains unrecovered on expiry of 80% of the original Contract period i.e., 9.6 months, the Contractor shall refund the amount by Demand Draft/ Banker's cheque immediately, failing which, the balance amount alongwith penal interest @ 2% over and above the prescribed rate of 10% for the delayed period shall be realized by invoking the Mobilization Advance Bank Guarantee(s).

#### 6.9 Arbitration / litigation:

If any dispute, difference or question at any time arises between the Parties in respect of the meaning or interpretation of the terms and conditions of this Agreement or covering anything herein contained or arising out of this Agreement or the validity of the enforcement thereof which cannot be settled mutually, shall within 30 (thirty) days (or such longer period as may be mutually agreed upon) from the date one Party informs the other in writing that such dispute or disputes or disagreement exists, be referred to Arbitration. Within 30 (thirty) days of the said notice, one Arbitrator shall be appointed by each of the disputing Parties by notice in writing to the other. The two Arbitrators shall select an Umpire whose decision shall be final in case of difference of opinion between the two Arbitrators.

The Arbitration proceedings will be conducted in accordance with and be subject to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (of India) as amended from time to time and the decision of the Arbitrators as mentioned above shall be final and binding on the Parties.

The Arbitration will have its sittings at Delhi.

The language to be used in the Arbitral proceedings will be English.

The Contractor shall continue to perform his duties as far as practicable with diligence notwithstanding the fact that a dispute has been referred to Arbitration or any dispute or difference has arisen. It is also the term of Agreement that if the Contractor does not make any demand for Arbitration in respect of any item in writing within 60 (sixty) days of receiving intimation from the Employer that the final bill is ready for payment, the claim of the Contractor will be deemed to have been waived and absolutely barred and the Employer shall be discharged and released of all liabilities under the Agreement in respect of these claims.

- **6.10 Delay in payment of Running Bill**: Employer would make payment of Running Account Bill (Payment of work done of all undisputed items) within the stipulated time but in case of delay no interest will be payable.
- 6.11 Escalation: No escalation on accepted tender cost will be permitted.
- 7. Defects Liability Period: Defects Liability period will be twelve months from date of completion of project.
- 8. Completion of project: The Period of Completion for the whole of the works is 12 (Twelve) months calculated from the date of commencement of works and the date of commencement of work will be deemed as 15 days from the handing over of the site.
