Advisory No. 2 for Indian Nationals Planning Travel to Nepal

The Department of Immigration, Government of Nepal has issued a new Notice on 28th April, 2021, elaborating upon and further clarifying its earlier notice dated 26th April, 2021. An excerpt of unofficial English translation applicable to Indian nationals is given below for information.

Government of Nepal Ministry of Home Department of Immigration

Date: 28 April 2021

In order to contain the new fast-spreading Covid 19 variants, this notice has been issued to implement the Cabinet decisions made on 26 April and clarify about the Department's notice published on the same date.

1. No nationals other than from the bordering neighbouring countries will be allowed to enter Nepal via land route.

2. All Indian nationals entering Nepal from land route will have to present their respective PCR reports clearing them of having contracted Covid, and that from samples collected within 72 hours. They must also produce a proof of a prior hotel reservation for 10 days to stay in quarantine.

3. All those entering Nepal via air route should present their respective PCR reports clearing them of having contracted Covid, and that from samples collected within 72 hours.

4. Nepali citizens arriving via air route will have to submit a negative PCR report and have to mandatorily stay in hotel or home quarantine for ten days.

5. All foreign nationals other than those using the airport as transit shall be barred from flying to third countries from Nepal. Foreign nationals those arrived already in Nepal may be allowed to depart via land or air routes.
