- 2. No bid shall be accepted after the scheduled date and time. The sealed cover should be super scribed "AUCTION OF FOR SALE OF OLD EMBASSY's CARS" with full name, contact number and postal address of the Bidder.
- 3. The last date of submission of the bids in sealed envelope is 03.06.2025 up to 03:00 pm. The bids must be dropped in the tender box kept at following address and same will be opened on 06.06.2025 at 03:30 PM.
- 4. A bidder must be/have a person/registered firm.
- 5. H-1/successful bidder will be decided per vehicle.

- 6. The conditional bid shall not be accepted.
- 7. The vehicle will be sold on "As is where is & whatever there is basis" and no guarantee or certificate of its worthiness or quality will be given by our department. No requests for inspection of vehicle other than as mention above (specified day & time) will be entertained.
- 8. The bidder shall furnish Earnest Money Deposit mentioned above by way of Demand Draft/ Pay Order/Cheque issued by a scheduled commercial bank in favor of 'Embassy of India, Kathmandu' payable at Nepal SBI Ltd., Extension Counter, Embassy of India, Kathmandu. The EMD of the unsuccessful bidder shall be returned subsequent to the award of contact to the successful bidder. No claim lies against Embassy of India in respect of erosion in the value or interest on the amount of EMD (i.e. EMD will be interest free). The bid without EMD will be summarily rejected.

The final sale amount (after adjusting of EMD amount) is to be deposited in the form of DD/PO/RTGS/NEFT/Cheque, failing which the earnest money will be forfeited.
- 10. The sold items are to be lifted from the site within a specified date from the issue of release order or such period as may be decided by the authority on an "as is where is and whatever there is basis".
- 11. The buyer will be responsible for safety and security of the sold items after delivery of items to the successful bidder. Embassy of India, will not be responsible for any damage/pilferage of the auctioned items.
- 12. The delivery of the sold vehicles will be given only to the successful/ H-1 Highest bidder.
- 13. The sold vehicle/s shall have to be removed by successful bidder at his own expenses from Embassy's premises.
