## India in Nepal Highlights



### Handing Over Ceremony of Cricket Equipment to Nepal National Cricket Team



In a program organised on 26 October 2023 by the Embassy of India, Kathmandu, Ambassador of India to Nepal Shri Naveen Srivastava handed over professional cricket equipment to Nepal Cricket Team Captain Rohit Kumar Paudel. 
