
MoUs for three projects to be implemented under Gol Grant Assistance in Nepal

This was the first visit of Foreign Secretary Lamsal to India since she assumed charge. During the meeting with Foreign Secretary of India, Shri Vinay Mohan Kwatra, the two Foreign Secretaries held discussions on the entire range of multifaceted cooperation between India and Nepal and also followed up on the 7th India-Nepal Joint Commission Meeting which was co-chaired by the External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar and the Foreign Minister of Nepal H.E. Mr. N. P. Saud in Kathmandu last month. The visit is in keeping with the tradition of regular high-level exchanges between the two countries and the priority India attaches to its relations with Nepal under its 'Neighbourhood First' policy, and will provide an opportunity to further advance bilateral ties.
