India's First Underwater Metro Transportation



Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi launched India's first underwater metro service the Howrah Maidan-Esplanade section of Kolkata Metro's East-West corridor on 6 March 2024. Built at a cost of Rs 4,965 crore, this engineering marvel is part of the 16.6 km of the East-West Metro corridor. The project is being executed by Kolkata Metro Rail Corporation Limited (KMRCL). Of the total East-West Metro corridor, nearly 10.8 km is underground, including the tunnel beneath the river. The project has been executed with enhanced safety measures, including using features like anti-collision and automatic train control mechanisms. In April 2023, a successful trial journey was also executed under the bed of Hooghly through a tunnel 32 metres below the water level for the first time in India.










Did you visit!

Kaziranga National Park



Kaziranga National Park is the place where the nature unwinds its pristine form in millions of hues, where wildlife roams fearlessly, where man and nature meets together. It is situated in the north-eastern part of India in the district of Golaghat and Nagoan in the state of Assam. It is the host for two third of world's population of endangered Indian onehorned rhinoceros and also holds the highest density of tigers in the world. Kaziranga National Park was declared as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO for its unique natural environment in 1985.
